# Website Privacy Policy

### **INTRODUCTION**

TUHRN Policy Solutions Inc. ("Company" or "We") respects your privacy and is committed to protecting it by complying with this policy. This privacy policy coincides with the Personal Information Protection and Electronic Documents Act (R.S.C. 2000, c.5) ("PIPEDA") of Canada.

# This policy describes:

- How we collect, use, disclose, and protect the personal information of our partners ("Customers") and website users ("you").
- Describes the types of information we may collect from you or that you may provide when you visit the website <a href="https://TUHRN.com">https://TUHRN.com</a> (our "Website").
- Our practices for collecting, using, maintaining, protecting, and disclosing that information.

We will only use your personal information in accordance with this policy unless otherwise required by applicable law. We take steps to ensure that the personal information that we collect about you is adequate, relevant, not excessive, and used for limited purposes.

Privacy laws in Canada generally define "personal information" as any information about an identifiable individual, which includes information that can be used on its own with other information to identify, contact, or locate a single person.

This policy applies to information we collect, use, or disclose about you:

- On this Website.
- In email, text, and other electronic messages between you and this Website.
- From the Google Form ("Website form") containing your submitted information.

The Website may include links to third-party websites, plug-ins, services, social networks, or applications. Clicking on those links or enabling those connections may allow the third party to collect or share data about you. If you follow a link to a third-party website or engage a third-party plugin, please note that these third parties have their own privacy policies and we do not accept any responsibility or liability for those policies. ## **INFORMATION WE COLLECT ABOUT YOU**

We collect and use several types of information from and about you, including:

  used to connect your computer to the Internet, user name or other similar identifier, and
  personal comments submitted via the form.

- Non-personal information, that does not directly or indirectly reveal your identity or directly
  relate to an identifiable individual, such as demographic information, or statistical information
  or aggregated information. Statistical or aggregated data does not directly identify a specific
  person, but we may derive non-personal statistical data from personal information. For
  example, we may aggregate personal information to calculate the percentage of users accessing
  a specific Website feature.
- **Technical information,** including your login information, browser type and version, time zone setting, browser plug-in types and versions, operating system and platform, or information about your Internet connection, the equipment you use to access out Website, and usage details.
- Non-personal details about your Website interactions, including the full Uniform Resource
  Locators (URLs), clickstream to, through and from our Website (including date and time),
  products you viewed or searched for, page response times, download errors, length of visits to
  certain pages, page interaction information (such as scrolling, clicks, and mouse-overs), methods
  used to browse away from the page, or any phone number used to call the Company.
- Business or other organization mentioned in submitted Website form, including a description
  of the business or organization (such as a non-profit organization, political party, government

We use different methods to collect your information, including through:

#### Information You Provide to Us

The information we collect directly from you on or through our Website may include:

## Information We Collect Through Cookies and Other Automatic Data Collection Technologies

As you navigate through and interact with our Website, we may use cookies or other automatic data collection technologies to collect certain information about your equipment, browsing actions, and patterns, including:

- Details of your visits to our Website, including traffic data, location data, logs, and other communication data and the resources that you access and use on the Website.
- Information about your computer and Internet connection, including you IP address, operating system, and browser type.

The information we collect automatically is statistical data and may include personal information and we may maintain it or associate it with personal information we collect in other ways, that you provide to us, or receive from third parties. It helps us to improve our Website and to deliver a better and more personalized service, including by enabling us to:

- Estimate our audience size and usage patterns.
- Store information about your preferences, allowing us to customize our Website according to your individual interests.
- Speed up your searches.
- Recognize you when you return to our Website.

The technologies we use for this automatic data collection may include:

Cookies (or browser cookies). A cookie is a small file placed on the hard drive of your computer.
 You may refuse to accept browser cookies by activating the appropriate setting on your
 browser. However, if you select this setting you may be unable to access certain parts of our
 Website. Unless you have adjusted your browser setting so that it will refuse cookies, our
 system will issue cookies when you direct your browser to our Website.

Flash cookies. Certain features of our Website may use local stored objects (or Flash cookies) to

Website. Flash cookies are not managed by the same browser settings that are used for browser

• **Web beacons.** Pages of our Website and our e-mails may contain small electronic files known as web beacons (also referred to as clear gifs, pixel tags, and single-pixel gifs) that permit the Company, for example, to count users who have visited those page or opened an email and for other related website statistics (for example, recording the popularity of certain website content and verifying system and server integrity).

We use information that we collect about you or that you provide to us, including any personal information:

  divestiture, restructuring, reorganization, dissolution, or other sale or transfer of some or all of
  Cwihun Strategic Solution Inc.'s assets, whether as a going concern or as part of bankruptcy,
  liquidation, or similar proceeding, in which personal information held by Cwihun Strategic
  Solution Inc.'s about our customers and users is among the assets transferred.
- To fulfill the purpose for which you provide it.
- For any other purpose disclosed by us when you provide the information.

We may also disclose your personal information:

- To comply with any court order, law, or legal process, including to respond to any government or regulatory request, in accordance with applicable law.
- To enforce or apply our contractual obligations as agreed to at the time of the relevant contract's signing.
- If we believe disclosure is necessary or appropriate to protect the rights, property, or safety of Cwihun Strategic Solutions Inc., our customers, or others. This includes exchanging information with other companies and organizations for the purposes of fraud protection and credit risk reduction.

### TRANSFERRING YOUR PERSONAL INFORMATION

We may transfer personal information that we collect or that you provide as described in this policy to contractors, service providers, and other third parties we use to support our business (such as analytics and search engine providers that assist us with Website improvement and optimization) and who are contractually obligated to keep personal information confidential, use it only for the purposes for which we disclose it to them, and to process the personal information with the same standards set out in this policy.

We may also process, store, and transfer personal information in and to a foreign country, with different privacy laws that may or may not be as comprehensive as Canadian law. In these circumstances, the governments, courts, law enforcement, or regulatory agencies of that country may be able to obtain access to your personal information through the laws of the foreign country. Whenever we engage a service provider, we require that its privacy and security standards adhere to this policy and applicable Canadian privacy legislation.
